SRJC is going to work with Redistricting Partners (visit their website!) to do a demographic analysis of trustee area 3/4/5, and potentially all trustee areas. Valuable learning experience for the SRJC, in terms of developing a new map. Recommendation 1: inquire with Dr. Chong and Doug Roberts on how students can be actively involved in the process and making the process more transparent (ex: website to maintain transparency with timeline on it). (2) SRJC is going to continue to work with School and Legal services to see if the SRJC can qualify for election waiver (to avoid the general/special election estimated to save ~\$250,00-750,000). As of today, 22 districts have received approval from the state to use the waiver, and only one district has used the ballot process to redistrict (look into Santa Barbara City College). School of legal services used College of the Redwoods as an example at the 2nd study session, which is nothing like what the SRJC is trying to do. Would be great for students to get involved in the process of working with Redistricting Partners.
